Highlights of the Regular Board Meeting of June 9, 2009

EL CAPITAN DARE TO DREAM

The Board of Trustees recognized El Capitan's Dare to Dream students for their work on campus this school year. Vice Principal Colette Bolger introduced three student representatives from the program, Athena Kiokaman, Vivian Lee and Manuel Barella, and also the director of the After School Program, Kevin Clifton.

EL CAPITAN SAFE SCHOOL EMBASSADORS

The Board of Trustees recognized students and staff members involved in El Capitan's Safe School Ambassador program. The program's unique student-centered, skills-based approach to violence-prevention is founded on research showing the power of student leaders to change social norms.

LIDDELL SCHOLARSHIP RECOGNITION

The Board of Trustees recognize the Liddell Family for their annual scholarship contribution to Central High School students. Their 2009 scholarship contribution totaled \$9,000. Mike Berg thanked the Liddells for their continued support of the district.

The Board of Trustees recognized Randy and Christy Rocca for receiving the ACSA Golden Apple Award. The Rocca Family is a long-time supporter of Central Unified. Mike Berg thanked the Roccas for their active involvement with the district over the past several years.

The Board of Trustees accepted the following gifts to the district:

- El Capitan Middle School received a donation of \$78 from PG&E Corporation Campaign for the Community on behalf of donor Edie DeLaCruz.

NOTICE OF COMPLETION

The Board of Trustees approved authorization to file the Notice of Completion for Phase I (Ashlan and Grantland) off-site street, storm drain, sewer and water plans. The project was awarded on May 23, 2006 to Construction Management Systems in the amount of \$4,991,350. There were eight subsequent Change Orders totaling \$355,752.11 for a revised total of \$5,347,102.11 which was funded by Measure K. The filing of this notice triggers a 35-day period within which mechanic liens must be filed. Once the filing period has passed, the district no longer bears liability for the sub-contractors of the prime contractor.

**2009-2010
ANNUAL
BUDGET**

The Board of Trustees received information regarding the adoption of the 2009-2010 annual budget. The State is now projecting a \$30 billion deficit by June 30, 2009. Revenue to school districts is projected to be reduced by \$357/Average Daily Attendance. For Central Unified, the reduction will be approximately \$4.8 million from the current year ending balance. A June 30, 2010 Fiscal Position Report including a projected 2008-2009 ending fund balance, projected revenue based on the State budget, and projected expenditures based on known cost inflation and proposed reductions was presented to the Board in draft form. The proposed 2009-2010 annual budget will be placed on the June 23, 2009 meeting agenda for public hearing and adoption.

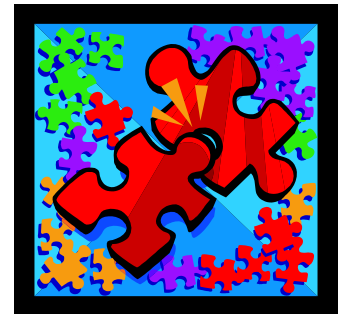
